It has occurred to me that the board members may not realize I did give John a price and that I may not have made that clear at the meeting. I did tell John I would accept \$365,000 for our stock. We have made two payments of over 4K and we are not financially able to make any more, so foreclosure it is. The price is based on a verbal appraisal of \$1,250,000 by Greg Roberson.
